

The event attracts over 270 of the finest artisans and dealers of living history supplies and related goods from throughout the United States.

The Kalamazoo Living History Show was created in 1976 to bring history alive and

entertain as well as expose visitors to some of the most fascinating times in our history. Each year the focus of the show changes allowing various historical reenactment groups, organizations, and individuals, dressed in period clothing, the opportunity to host the show and share their knowledge and enthusiasm of history with all of us.
